Are you wondering what to do with your kids while you volunteer for one of the amazing jobs at Old Settler's Days? Well if they are in 5th grade or above you can bring your kid along to help as well. Normally we have 5th/6th/7th graders helping with drinks. We offer soda, water, tea, power aid as our main drink options and these are all stored in an assortment of coolers at the end of the line. The kids work to keep drinks stocked, iced and ready to serve. To get a rough idea on numbers in 2017 we sold nearly 2700 sodas, over 1200 waters, nearly 460 Powerade's and 178 tea drinks. That is 4500 plus interactions of our great students with the community and they do a great job showing off all the great life lessons learned from attending St. Mary's.

As a reminder, Old Settler's Days are scheduled for June 23-26 and we are in need of 300+ spots to be filled and your kids can be just as much of the solution as you.
