Old Settler's Front Line Server Description

Do you like to smile, laugh and have a good time? Enjoy fast paced activities, like grabbing five different items and perfectly placing them on a tray? The front line server area is the position for those who like to be busy with a smile, and just the right amount of chit chat. Come June 22-26 we will need 47 spots filled for this critical role. The front line server spot is our first contact point with our guests and have the tall order of being friendly and welcoming but also keeping the line moving during busy times. In 2017, these people helped hand out over 5,600 food items to our guests as a reference point.

If you volunteer for a shift as a front line server the expectations will be that you man a portion of the line and as people come by you help them get the food they are wanting. This could mean that you are communicating orders for nachos, hot dogs, or BBQ back to the corner of the tent and helping get that food moved to the guest's tray. It could also mean that you are handing out various options of Steakburgers and fries, while also keeping the chefs in the back up to date on what is needed next. Another option, my favorite, is wrapping up a fresh porkchop sandwiches and yelling "Porkchop" as loud as possible to let the grill guy to toss another one on. No cooking skills required for this role, just a willingness to be flexible and polite.

In general we aim to have 2/3 people working the serving line during the slow times and 3/4 during busy times. There are times when things go smoothly and then there are times the line is backed 50 feet out the tent, we are short some burgers and we make the best of it to keep people happy and smiling as they wait for a fresh Porkchop to come off the grill. This is a great spot to volunteer for if you are new to the whole food tent scene, so as you mark down June 22-26 on your calendar, this may be a great spot for a first time volunteer to get a better understanding of how the whole food tent works.
